Women's Tournament Rules

Please Read Carefully & Share With Your Team Members

1. Tournament is open to all women members of the Indy USBC Association who have bowled at least 9 games in the current season. Unmarried students under the age of eighteen (18) must file a parental consent form.
2. This tournament will consist of a four-person Team event, Singles event, Doubles event and optional 9-game All Events. Participants will bowl 3 games in each event.
3. **TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEE will be \$30 per person, per event** (team, singles, and doubles). Optional all events fee will be \$5. Entry fee includes \$15 prize fund and \$15 tournament expenses. Entries must be accompanied with total fees with checks made payable to "Indy USBC – Women's Tournament".
4. **HANDICAP** is based on 90% of 210 for Singles and optional All Events. Doubles and Team events are based on a combined average of the team members.
5. **OPTIONAL SCRATCH EVENTS** will be \$10 per person, per event. Optional scratch all events fee will be \$5. Participants who have entered and paid the fees for the regular handicap tournament may enter any or all of the optional scratch events (team, singles, doubles, and 9-game all events) by payment of the optional fee(s). **To be eligible for team scratch, all team members must enter as scratch. For doubles scratch, both partners must enter scratch.** Any participant may enter singles or all events scratch.
6. **OPTIONAL ALL EVENTS:** Cost of optional All Events Handicap is \$5 and optional All Events Scratch is \$5.00. Prizes will be paid in each division and will be determined by the division the entrant qualifies for in their SINGLES EVENT. All Events fees must be paid prior to the bowler competing in **ANY** event of the tournament. The first score bowled in any event will be used for the individual's all events total.
7. **AVERAGES:** Entrants must use their HIGHEST USBC winter or summer league yearbook average as of the end of the previous season - minimum 21 games. If an entrant does not have a previous year's average, they will use their highest current USBC league average at the time of the tournament competition - minimum of 21 games. Sport averages will only be converted and used if it is the only average available. **A LEAGUE STANDING SHEET IS REQUIRED AT CHECK-IN. ANYONE WITHOUT A VERIFIED AVERAGE AS OF THE TIME THEY COMPETE IN THE TOURNAMENT WILL BOWL SCRATCH.** Bowlers may elect to bowl in a higher division but must notify the tournament staff prior to bowling to have captain sheet(s) adjusted. **Rules 319 a2 (10-pin rule), b (prize winnings), c, d, & e (entering average adjustment) DO NOT APPLY.**
8. Each bowler is responsible for verifying the accuracy of the average being used. Average corrections must be made by the end of the first game. Incorrect averages are subjected to re-rating or disqualification per Tournament Manager's discretion.
9. **MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION** is permitted providing not more than two (2) players on the same team compete together more than once. Each team is limited to no more than one (1) professional (PBA) card members. Doubles partners are limited to 1 PBA member and partners must change for each squad bowled must change for each squad bowled. Singles event can also be entered multiple times, however, only one cash prize will be awarded.
10. **SUBSTITUTIONS** are allowed. Provided the Tournament Manager is advised of the substitution at least 30 minutes prior to the start of competition. The new bowler will take the place of the bowler they are replacing on the roster. When the average of the substitute changes the classification of an entry, such entry shall be reclassified accordingly. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the entry fee paid, nor shall they be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or award they may win. **A SUBSTITUTE WITHOUT A VERIFIED AVERAGE PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING IN THE TOURNAMENT WILL BOWL SCRATCH.**
11. Any player or team arriving after tournament play has started will receive zero for the frames missed.
12. Team captains and singles/doubles participants must check in at least **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled bowling time.
13. **WALK-INS** are accepted and must pay an additional \$10 per event – **CASH ONLY**. Walk-ins must arrive at least 20 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time.
14. Entries received after the early entry deadline date of Thursday, December 29th will be considered walk-in and charged an additional \$10 per bowler. All walk-in fees must be paid in **CASH**.
15. Any scoring errors must be called to the attention of a tournament official immediately or within 24 hours of being bowled. Protests affecting eligibility or playing rules must be submitted/confirmed in writing to the Tournament Manager within 72 hours and before the tournament prize payments are made.
16. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the Indy USBC Association, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees, if and when these entries shall be, through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule changes, or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, national emergency, or emergencies of causes relating thereto or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Indy USBC Association.
17. Any situation not covered under these tournament rules will be governed by the USBC tournament rules.
