- 1. <u>ELIGIBILITY</u>: This event is open to all 2015-16 certified USBC youth members. All adult bowlers must be USBC certified members. If an adult is not presently a 2015-2016 USBC member, an associate membership can be purchased at the time of check-in (\$21.00 which covers you for the 2016-17 bowling season) or they may pay a \$5.00 tournament participation fee. <u>Current USBC membership cards must be shown at check-in</u>.
- 2. <u>DATES & LOCATION</u>: The tournament will be held beginning Monday, July 18, 2016 and run thru Saturday, July 23, 2016 at Hindel Bowl. Squad dates and times are listed on front page.
- 3. ENTRY FEE / DEADLINE DATE: A \$40.00 entry fee is required per doubles team (\$10.00 lineage \$8.00 expense fee, and \$22.00 scholarship fee). The early registration deadline is Thursday, June 30, 2016. Entries postmarked after that date will be charged an additional \$5.00 fee. Re-entries will be allowed on a first-come, first served basis if space permits.
- 4. <u>TEAMS & DIVISIONS</u>: Each doubles team must consist of one (1) USBC youth bowler (not required to be a 2016 Junior Gold or Youth Open participant) plus one (1) USBC adult bowler (must not be a 2016 Junior Gold or Youth Open participant). The USBC adult bowler may be a parent, grandparent, sibling, coach, friend, etc. There is no age requirement for the adult bowler. There will be a separate Boys and Girls division in both the 11 & Under and 12 & Over divisions. The gender and age of the youth bowler as of August 1, 2015 will determine the division.
- 5. ON-SITE REGISTRATION: On-site registration before and after Monday, July 18, 2016 will be at Hindel Bowling Center and cost \$45.00 (CASH ONLY); acceptance will be on a first-come, first-served basis, based upon squad time and lane availability. Entries will also be accepted at the Adult/Youth table/station during athlete registration for the Junior Gold Championships (this optional location is for Junior Gold athletes only).
- 6. LANE ASSIGNMENTS & CHECK-IN: Lanes will be assigned by the order of entries received. Each team <u>must check in at least twenty (20) minutes prior to their assigned squad time to receive their lane assignments</u>. Any bowlers checking in late will receive zero (0) for any missed frames. Late bowlers may elect to reschedule to another available squad on a first come, first serve bases, however, no refunds will be given.
- 7. <u>FORMAT</u>: Each doubles team will bowl four (4) Baker-style games. Baker-style games are where one bowler throws the first frame and their partner throws the next frame. The youth bowler will begin games one (1) and three (3); the adult bowler will begin games two (2) and four (4). Teams will bowl all four (4) games on their assigned pair of lanes. The lane condition will be a modified house pattern with no re-dressing of lanes between squads. This is a USBC certified scratch tournament.
- 8. <u>SCHOLARSHIPS</u>: The scholarship portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% with scholarships held in the USBC SMART Program in Arlington, TX. Scholarships will be awarded on a 1:6 ratio or major portion thereof in each division to the USBC youth bowler only. A USBC youth bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament; however, they may only receive one (1) scholarship with the same partner.
