TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entry is open to all members of the INDY USBC ASSOCIATION who are 50 years of age or older at the time of the tournament. Uncertified bowlers may qualify for entry in the Senior Tournament by paying a participation fee of \$5.00. Rule 300c 1b.
2. USBC certification cards MUST BE PRESENTED AT THE TIME OF CHECK-IN. All rules apply both male and female entrants.
3. Multiple entries are permitted, however, only one three game prize per bowler will be awarded. No re-entry after the last scheduled squad.
4. Each bowler will bowl three games for scoring purposes.
5. The tournament will be divided into five classes:

CLASS A - 70 YEARS AND OLDER	CLASS C - 60 TO 64 YEARS
CLASS B - 65 TO 69 YEARS	CLASS D - 55 TO 59 YEARS
CLASS E— 50 TO 54 YEARS	
6. Handicap will be 100% of the difference between the bowlers average and 210.
6. All prizes will be returned 100% and awarded on a handicap basis only, First place awards will be presented for each handicap winner in each class for both men and women.
7. Prize ratio will be 1 in 5.
8. Entering average:
 - a. Last season highest INDY USBC yearbook average will be used including summer averages from 2016—17.
 - b.** If no average last year, highest current season USBC certified league average as of MARCH 17, 2018 for 21 or more games. **If no standing sheet is presented, then bowler will bowl scratch until one is provided to the association office.**
 - c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages will use a 210 average
 - d. USBC Rule 319d (reporting prize money) will not apply.
 - e. Rule 319c will apply to USBC entrants.
9. Failure to use current average shall disqualify scores, HOWEVER, corrections may be permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series. (In accordance with USBC Rule 319a3, if submitted average is lower than correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap, score will be disqualified unless correction is made.) Prize winnings shall be based on submitted average if it is higher than the correct average.
10. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC, Rule 329 regarding “appeals”.
